Excellent international students make out an important building block in our vision - "Chalmers - a globally outstanding university of technology, for a better world". Scholarships are necessary tools in our endeavor to attract some of the brightest students from around the world.

In 2029, Chalmers celebrates 200 years, and we aim to raise 200 MSEK to create a jubilee foundation to be used for various projects supporting our endeavor to offer world-class education. One goal within the jubilee foundation is to raise a total of 50 MSEK to create a fund that will offer scholarships to international students (non-EU* students in general) of which a minimum of 10 MSEK specifically dedicated for US scholarships. The US part of the scholarship campaign, since it will run between the two anniversaries goes under the name of "75 – 200 in 5 years".

There's a proud tradition of philanthropy at Chalmers, dating back all the way to the start in 1829, when Chalmers was founded thanks to a large donation from William Chalmers. The tradition of giving back...or paying it forward, has continued through generous alumni and friends. Odd Albert and Gunnar Nicholson, who hosted the first alumni gathering in the US, were both great philanthropists who donated funds to Chalmers and other institutions to support students and scholars both in Sweden and the US. Odd Albert's donation to Chalmers still generates about 100 000 SEK annually as scholarships awarded to gifted students. Gunnar Nicholson made 4 donations, each for 1 MUSD in 1984, 3 of which had the purpose of supporting research collaboration between the U.S. and Sweden and one to the U.S. engineering association, TAPPI, to give out an annual award to replace the TAPPI medal.

In more recent years, US Friends of Chalmers was founded by a group of alumni in 2002 as a 501 (c) 3 organization to raise funds through some large and many small donations in support of Chalmers. The first scholarship was awarded in 2012 and since then, 18 scholarships have been awarded to US students, some thanks to a generous donation by the Barbro Osher Pro Suecia Foundation to the U.S. Friends of Chalmers scholarship program. campaign.

Another fantastic scholarship program at Chalmers is the Sievert Larsson Scholarship for Thai students. This program is funded by the Sievert Larsson Scholarship Foundation and has supported scholarships at Chalmers since 2010. Over the years, well over 30 Thai students have been given the opportunity to get their master's degrees at Chalmers thanks to the generosity of Sievert Larsson, also known as Mr Sievert.

With this campaign, we want to secure the availability of scholarships for the foreseeable future instead of relying on year-to-year donations. All donations matter and many small donations go a long way to drum up engagement and build a culture of giving – we hope you want to support this mission!




